




### **CAVITIES, SUGARS & ACIDS**

Have you been surprised to hear that you have a cavity in one or more of your teeth? Surprised because you tend to have a relatively low sugar diet? Many of you are aware that sugars are great disguisers. Simple sugar molecules can hide in longer, more intricate structures and go by other names, such as starches present in breads, etc, which aren't even necessarily sweet.

You have heard about cavities probably since the first candy that entered your mouth. Parents all over the world know that sugars are a cause of decay. Even in the most recent movie rendition of *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*, which portrays little Willy Wonka's father as a dentist, refers to lollipops as "cavity on a stick". While sugars do play a part in the breakdown of tooth enamel, they are not the sole culprit of the creation of cavities. The true culprit to the demineralization of tooth structure is pH.

Tooth enamel is susceptible to breakdown in the presence of an acidic environment through a process called erosion. Prolonged exposure to acid is what really does damage to teeth. So where does this acid come from? Acids are created by bacteria already present in our mouths as they process and digest sugars. If this acid produced is not "stirred around" by brushing, flossing, or waterpik action, changes in the enamel can begin to occur in as little as 20 minutes. Acids can also come from our diet. Fruit juices, sodas, coffee, wine, salad dressings all contribute to lowering the pH in our mouths. Acids can also come from our bodies in the form of reflux disease. This occurs when digestive acids somehow make it back into the mouth which produces an acidic wash over our teeth.

With all these potential acid attacks, you may be wondering how you even still have any teeth left? Our natural built-in acid defense lies right where we need it, right in our mouths, our salivary glands. Saliva lends many helpful attributes, one of which is a buffering agent to low pH events. Saliva can buy us more time in between brushings by regulating the acid level in our mouths. Toothpastes also lend to us helpful ions which can help to even re-build demineralized enamel. By making the ions which were lost in the acid bath available to demineralized teeth, the building blocks of fluoride, calcium, and phosphate are ready to remineralize! Now when your hygienist hands you a tube of ClinPro or MI Paste or Fluoridex, you will know exactly what it is for!

#### FILLING REPLACEMENT

The above show the replacement of a leaky metal filling with a tooth-colored filling. Metal fillings that have been in the tooth for a long time can begin to break down and leak. Bacteria can infect the tooth under the filling, causing the tooth to weaken. Tooth-colored fillings can restore and rejuvenate those teeth!





#### **FULL MOUTH RESTORATION**

The above before and after photos show a severely worn set of teeth which were fully restored by Dr. Pam Dassenko. Note in the before photo that the front teeth have shortened over the years from wear and tear. These teeth are likely to chip and break even more. With a well-trained dentist, broken down teeth can be restored to a beautiful, functional, and harmonious smile!
